About the YASHADA:

Yashwantrao Chavan Academy of Development Administration (YASHADA) is the Administrative Training Institute of the Government of Maharashtra which meets the training needs of government departments and rural and urban non-officials. Human resource development has traditionally been one of Maharashtra's major strengths. The importance of evolving sound and responsive administrative systems was realized as far back as 1963 when the Administrative Staff College (ASC) was established in Mumbai. The ASC was relocated at Pune in 1984 and renamed "Maharashtra Institute of Development Administration" (MIDA).MIDA, constituted as an autonomous society under the Societies Registrations Act, 1860, was to serve as the apex body for promoting and developing modern management practices and was to function as the nodal state level training institute in the field of development Administration" (YASHADA) in 1990, as a tribute to the pioneering spirit of the late Shri Y. B. Chavan, former Chief Minister of Maharashtra & Deputy Prime Minister of India, who had inspired the setting up of the ASC.

About the Dr. Ambedkar Competitive Examination Centre (ACEC): UPSC guidance and coaching Centre

During the last couple of decades, awareness about the Civil Services as a rewarding career has been growing at a very fast pace. The number of candidates taking up these examinations is growing exponentially. However it is seen that majority of the candidates from rural areas of Maharashtra, especially those from the weaker sections of the society are still unaware of the Civil Services Examinations conducted by the UPSC.

Dr. Ambedkar Competitive Examination Center (ACEC) was set up at YASHADA, Pune under the Schedule Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) of Department of Social Justice and Special Assistance, Government of Maharashtra & Started functioning from 3rd July 2006 for providing guidance to the Candidates from weaker section of the society from Maharashtra.

In 2010, State Minority Commission & Minority Development Section, GoM has approved 10 seats for the Candidates of the Minority Community & provided financial support.

In 2012, Tribal Development Department, GoM has approved 10 seats for the Candidates of the Tribal.

ACEC aims at tapping the talent in Candidates, encouraging them and helping them to prepare for the Civil Services examination.

Objectives:

- To create awareness regarding examinations, particularly civil services examinations among the youth from the deprived sections of the Society in Maharashtra.
- To plan and conduct guidance and training programmes for selected candidates.
- To provide support with facilities like residence, library, study room, test series, internet facility etc with subject/Paper-Wise qualitative Guidance from eminent administrators, academicians, professional experts and successful ex-students for the examination.

Scope of the Centre:

Candidates who are Maharashtra domiciled only can take advantage of this Programme.

Funds:

The Centre is being funded by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Research and Training Institute (BARTI), Minority Commission through Dept. of the Minority Development, GoM, and TRTI, Tribal Development Department, GoM.

- Full time candidates will not be allowed to do any other courses / job simultaneously.
