# FIR(FIRST INFORMATION REPORT)

- It is generally a complaint lodged with the police by the victim of a cognizable offense under section 154 crpc(either written or orally).
- Police officer must help the victim or person who filed FIR.

# Modes of complaint

## ***offline fir***

1. we have to go police station for lodging a complint.
2. in writing or verbally.
3. Recorded by police officer.
4. Person must sign the FIR.
5. Individual must get copy of FIR.

## **Online fir**

1. Can lodge complaint from anywhere.
2. Recorded directly by us.
3. Only written complaint.
4. Sign not required.
5. After registration we can see our digital FIR copy.

# How to register online FIR

1. In the case of cognisable offences complaint or FIR can be filed online.
2. Visit the official website. { MH police services for citizens}.
3. Click on online services.
4. Fill the registration form.
  - police station name
  - subject

- Address
- City
- Phone
- Name & mail
- Authorised code
- complaint
- Complaint type.

5. Recheck the details before clicking the submit button.

6. Check your e-mail id for a copy of the e-report and take a print out for future reference.

7. After submission of *FIR Application Form Online* can also track their *FIR Status* on the portal.

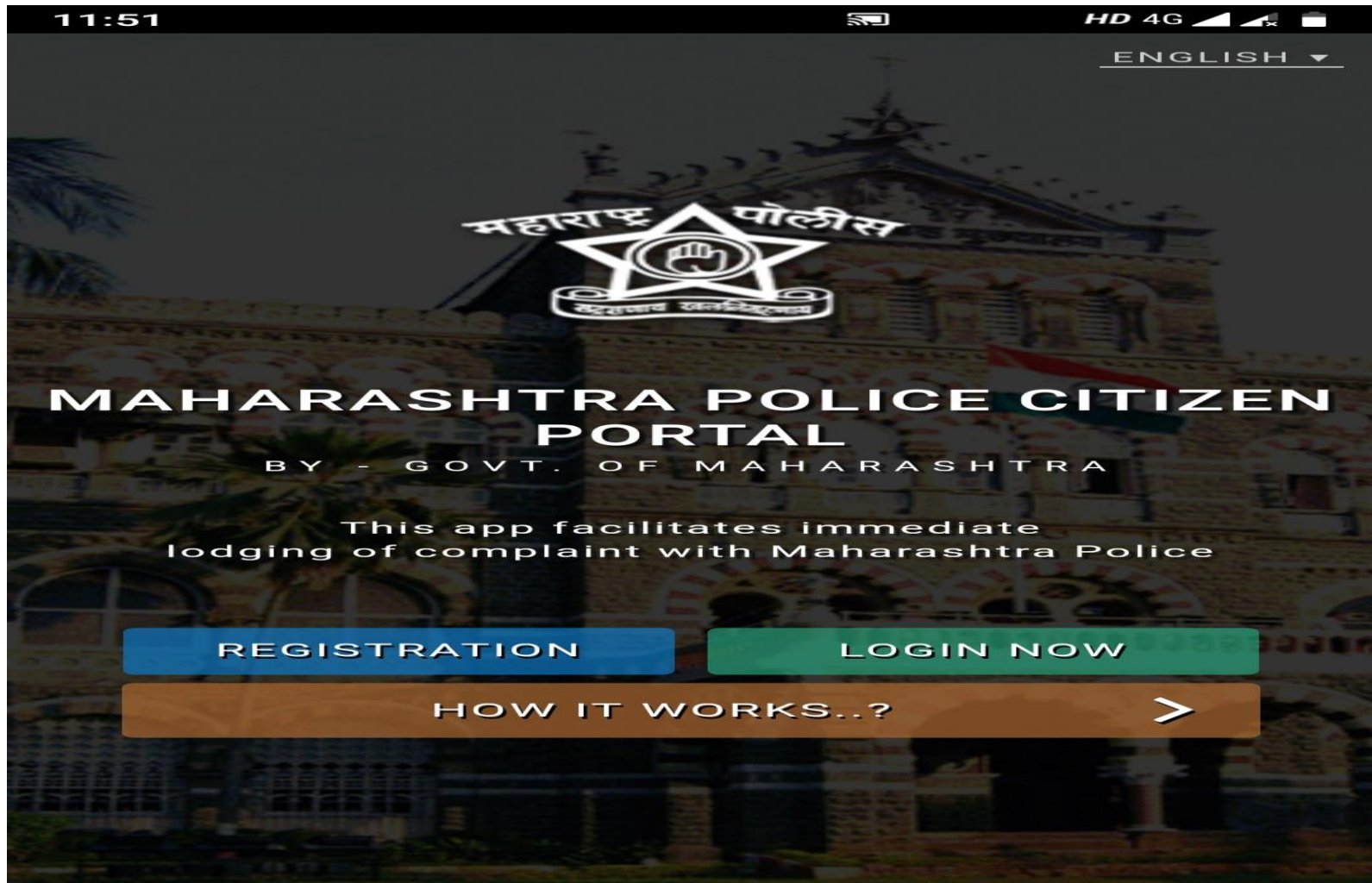
