Rural Governance & Fiscal Decentralisation, Economics for Rural Management, Organizational Behaviour & Human Resource Management, Management of Rural Services and Institutions, Farm Services Management, Agri-Business Management, Co – Operative & Collective Action, Managerial Accounting & Finance, Research Method and Marketing Management.
